

EUROPE'S LARGEST REAL ESTATE CHARITY GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP RUN BY TRISTAN RAISES RECORD

London – Pan-European real estate manager Tristan Capital Partners raised over £200,000 – an event record – for The Black Heart Foundation at its charity Golf Championship held at the prestigious Wentworth Club in Surrey to the west of London on Thursday 19th July. Around 240 real estate investment industry figures, sports personalities, and others, were present at the tournament, which was presided over by two-time UK Open winner Greg Norman and hosted by Tristan's Chief Executive Ric Lewis.

Greg Norman, an Australian golf legend, was World Number One for 331 weeks during his illustrious playing career and was inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame in 2001.

"It has been another superb event," commented Ric Lewis, Chief Executive and Chairman of Tristan Capital Partners. EYLA provides emotional and educational support for young African and Caribbean males who are at risk of social exclusion, offering them an opportunity to fulfil their potential and become the next generation of successful leaders.

It was the 12th edition of the Tristan Capital Partners Charity Golf Championship – the largest such event held within the European real estate industry – which fittingly took place on the opening day of this year's Open Championship, a tournament Norman won twice as a player. Some 170 golfers competed on the Wentworth West, Edinburgh and Executive courses, including a number of recognizable faces from the world of sport, entertainment, and the private equity real estate industry.

"With golf back on the Olympics agenda and London 2012 just around the corner I am delighted that we have been able to play our part for the EYLA," added Lewis. "One of the goals of EYLA is to spur intellectual curiosity through contact with successful people in diverse professions, and everyone enjoying the day together is what it is all about."

Another highlight of the day was an after-dinner 'TaylorMade Floodlit Par-3 Challenge' which took place from the Wentworth terrace to the 18th green on The East Course, marking the end of a fantastic day of golf and fund raising.
